The ad hoc committee shall resolve conflicts that arise between the SAC and the IAC and shall define the jurisdiction of the SAC and the IAC. THE DIRECTOR SHALL ESTABLISH THE STATE APPRENTICESHIP COUNCIL TO PROVIDE ADVICE AND GUIDANCE TO THE STATE APPRENTICESHIP AGENCY ON THE OPERATION OF THE STATE'S APPRENTICESHIP SYSTEM.
 - (b) THE SAC:
 - (I) IS COMPOSED OF PERSONS FAMILIAR WITH APPRENTICEABLE OCCUPATIONS;
 - (II) INCLUDES AN EQUAL NUMBER OF REPRESENTATIVES OF EMPLOYER AND EMPLOYEE ORGANIZATIONS AND INCLUDES MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC WHO MUST NOT NUMBER MORE THAN THE NUMBER OF REPRESENTATIVES OF EITHER EMPLOYER OR EMPLOYEE ORGANIZATIONS;
 - (III) INCLUDES ALL THE MEMBERS OF THE CABCT AND CANEI;
 - (c) THE CHAIRS OF THE CABCT AND CANEI SHALL SERVE AS CO-CHAIRS OF THE SAC.
 - (1.5) THE SAC MAY CONVENE ADDITIONAL SUBCOMMITTEES AS NEEDED TO FULFILL ITS DUTIES.
 - (2) The ad hoc committee of the SAC and the IAC SAC shall:
- 35 (a) Publish a statement defining the SAC's CABCT's jurisdiction 36 of the building and construction trades, and update the statement 37 periodically as necessary as determined by the ad hoc committee SAC;

- 2 (b) Resolve conflicts and complaints that arise between the SAC 3 CABCT and the IAC CANEI as determined by the ad hoc committee 4 SAC.
- 5 (3) If there is a tie among the ad hoc committee SAC members in determining a resolution to a conflict, the director shall break the tie. A decision of the ad hoc committee SAC is final.".

- "SECTION 40. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby
