- (1) THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES ENERGY AND ENVIRONMENT COMMITTEE SHALL INVESTIGATE CARBON DIOXIDE MITIGATION IN THE STATE, WHICH INVESTIGATION MUST EXPLORE THE FOLLOWING:
- (a) The costs and benefits of carbon dioxide mitigation; and $% \left(1\right) =\left(1\right) \left(1\right)$
- (b) THE ACTUAL ANTICIPATED IMPACTS OF MITIGATION WITH RESPECT TO THE TOTAL ATMOSPHERE, INCLUDING INTERACTIONS AND CONTRIBUTIONS FROM WATER VAPOR AND THE HYDROSPHERE.
- (2) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "ACTUAL ANTICIPATED IMPACTS" MEANS IMPACTS THAT HAVE GREATER THAN A MODERATE OR MEDIUM DEGREE OF CONFIDENCE IN OCCURRING.
- (3) On or before the conclusion of the second regular session of the state's seventy-fourth general assembly, the committee shall publish a report of its investigation and findings on the committee's website and submit a copy of the report to the governor.
 - (4) This section is repealed, effective September 1, 2024.".
