- 3 "SECTION 1. Short title. The short title of this act is the "Due 4 Process Asset Forfeiture Act".
  - **SECTION 2.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 16-13-701, **amend** (5)(a)(V)(B) and (5)(a)(VIII)(D) as follows:
    - 16-13-701. Reports related to seizures and forfeitures legislative declaration definitions. (5) Based upon the information received on the forms submitted pursuant to subsection (4) of this section, the department shall establish and maintain a searchable, public access database that includes the following, if known at the time of reporting:
    - (a) Information from each case in which a reporting agency received any forfeiture proceeds specifying:
      - (V) The type of property seized:
    - (B) If property other than currency, any make OR model or serial number related to the property and the estimated net equity VALUE of the property;
      - (VIII) Information relating to any forfeiture proceeding including:
    - (D) If any owner was determined by the court to be an innocent owner. The outcome of the forfeiture proceeding, including whether the property owner defaulted in the forfeiture litigation; the court determined the property owner was an innocent owner; or the property was forfeited by court order, settlement, or part of a plea agreement;
    - **SECTION 3.** Act subject to petition effective date applicability. (1) This act takes effect September 1, 2023; except that, if a referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act within the ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in November 2024 and, in such case, will take effect January 1, 2025, or on the date of the official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor, whichever is later.
- 35 (2) This act applies to seizures on or after the applicable effective date of this act.
