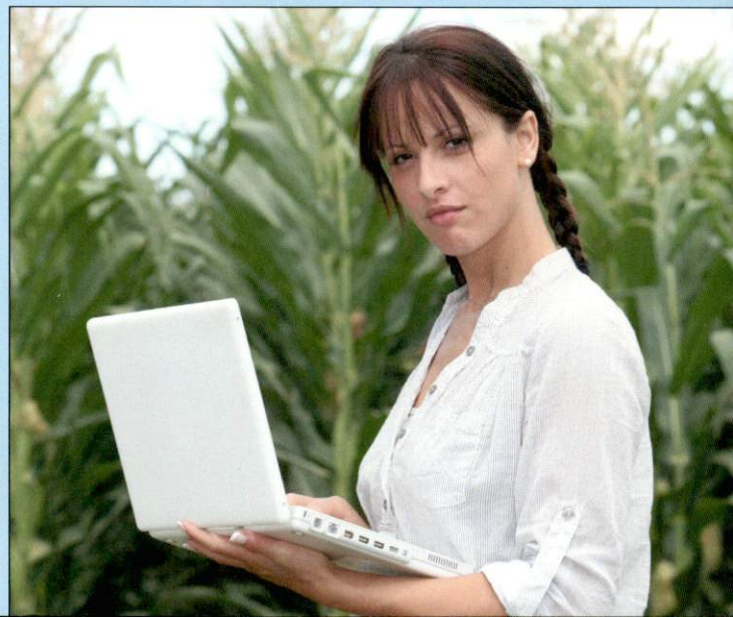
Students enrolling in the certificate courses must be actively operating a farm, ranch and/or agricultural related business or in the process of developing an agriculture business plan.

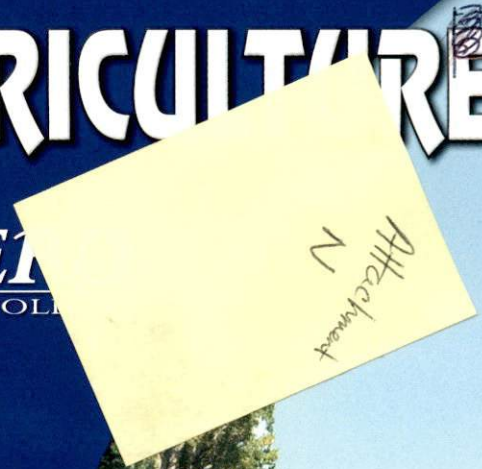
