Mesa county data - first 6 months of 2015, 2016, and 2017 - showing dramatic increases in felony filings. Why?

The % in () are the % of people in those categories who are arrested on a new felony crime while under that supervision type.

The main point - our generous release / PR rate in Mesa County (approx. 90% release rate) is NOT the cause of the increase in felony filings (a 1% increase from 2015 - 2017).

The other types of supervision have much more dramatic increases in re-arrest for a felony while on supervision.

2015 felonies: 770

number on pretrial supervision: 83 (10.77%)

number on probation: 109 (14.15%)

number on parole: 21 (2.72%)

2016 felonies: 1009 (up 31%)

number on pretrial supervision: 140 (13.87%)

number on probation: 255 (25.27%)

number on parole: 33 (3.27%)

2017 felonies: 1220 (up 21%)

number on pretrial supervision: 145 (11.88%)

number on probation: 270 (22.13%)

number on parole: 54 (4.42%)
