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# A BILL FOR AN ACT CONCERNING THE WILDFIRE MATTERS REVIEW COMMITTEE, AND, IN CONNECTION THEREWITH, DEFERRING THE DATE ON WHICH THE COMMITTEE IS SCHEDULED TO REPEAL.

## **Bill Summary**

**Wildfire Matters Review Committee.** The wildfire matters review committee (WMRC) is currently scheduled to repeal on July 1, 2018. The bill defers the repeal date to September 1, 2025.

The bill also eliminates obsolete provisions relating to the WMRC's consideration of codifying the wildland and prescribed fire

advisory commission, an entity created by executive order. The WMRC discharged its obligation by considering this issue during the 2014 legislative session.

1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado: 2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 2-3-1602, amend (7); 3 and **repeal** (1.5) as follows: 4 2-3-1602. Wildfire matters review committee - creation -5 repeal of part. (1.5) (a) In 2014, in addition to any other matters it 6 considers, the committee shall consider the creation of a Colorado 7 wildland and prescribed fire advisory commission under the division of 8 fire prevention and control in the department of public safety, also 9 referred to in this subsection (1.5) as the "advisory commission". The 10 purpose of the advisory commission will be to assist the director of the 11 division of fire prevention and control in performing his or her duties. 12 The committee shall make specific findings and recommendations 13 regarding the appropriate composition of the advisory commission, length 14 of terms, and the types of expertise and interests that should be 15 represented. 16 (b) On or before December 1, 2014, the committee shall submit 17 its specific recommendations pertaining to the advisory commission to the 18 agriculture, livestock, and natural resources committee of the house of 19 representatives and the agriculture, natural resources, and energy 20 committee of the senate, or any successor committees. Nothing in this 21 paragraph (b) prevents the committee from proposing legislation 22 regarding the creation of the advisory commission. 23 (c) Repealed. 24 (7) This part 16 is repealed, effective July 1, 2018 SEPTEMBER 1,
