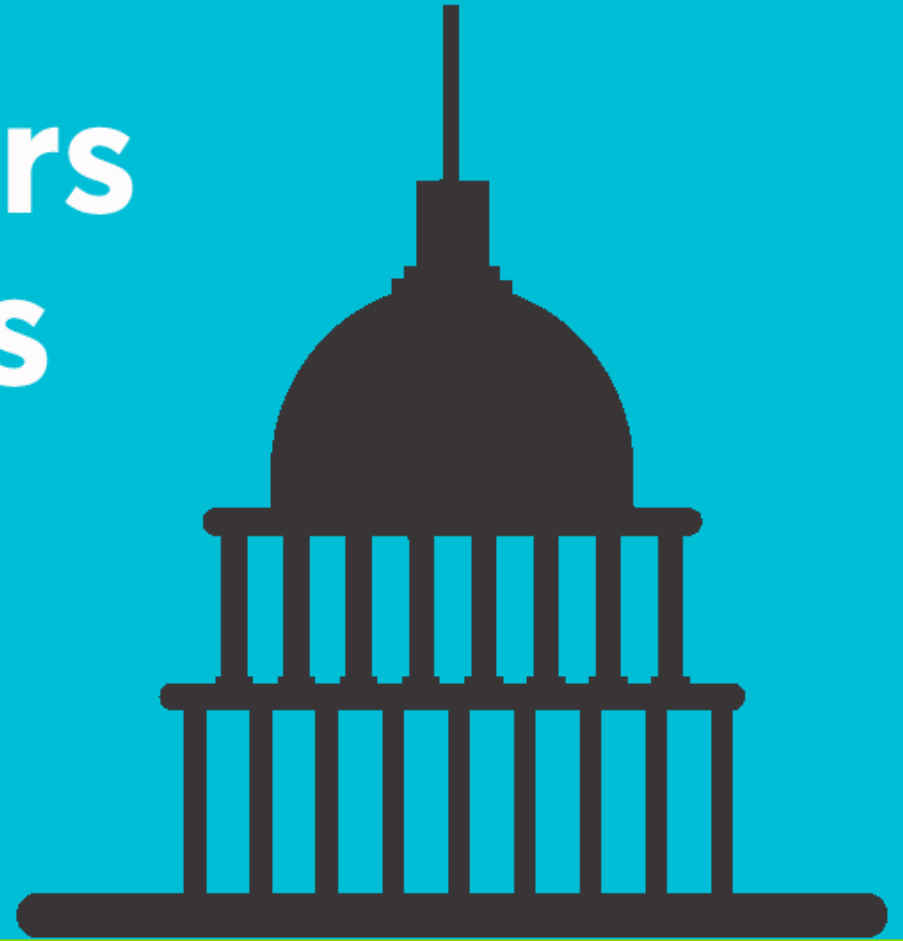

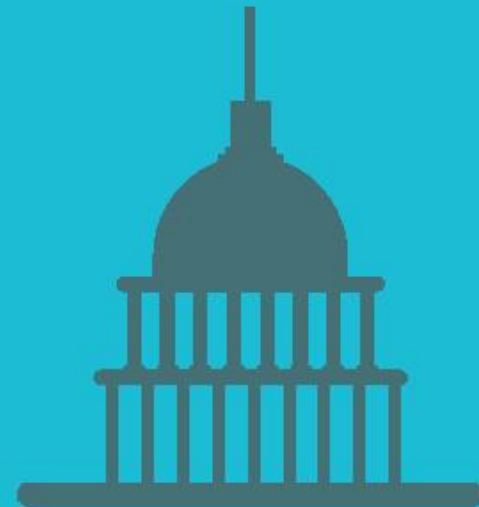

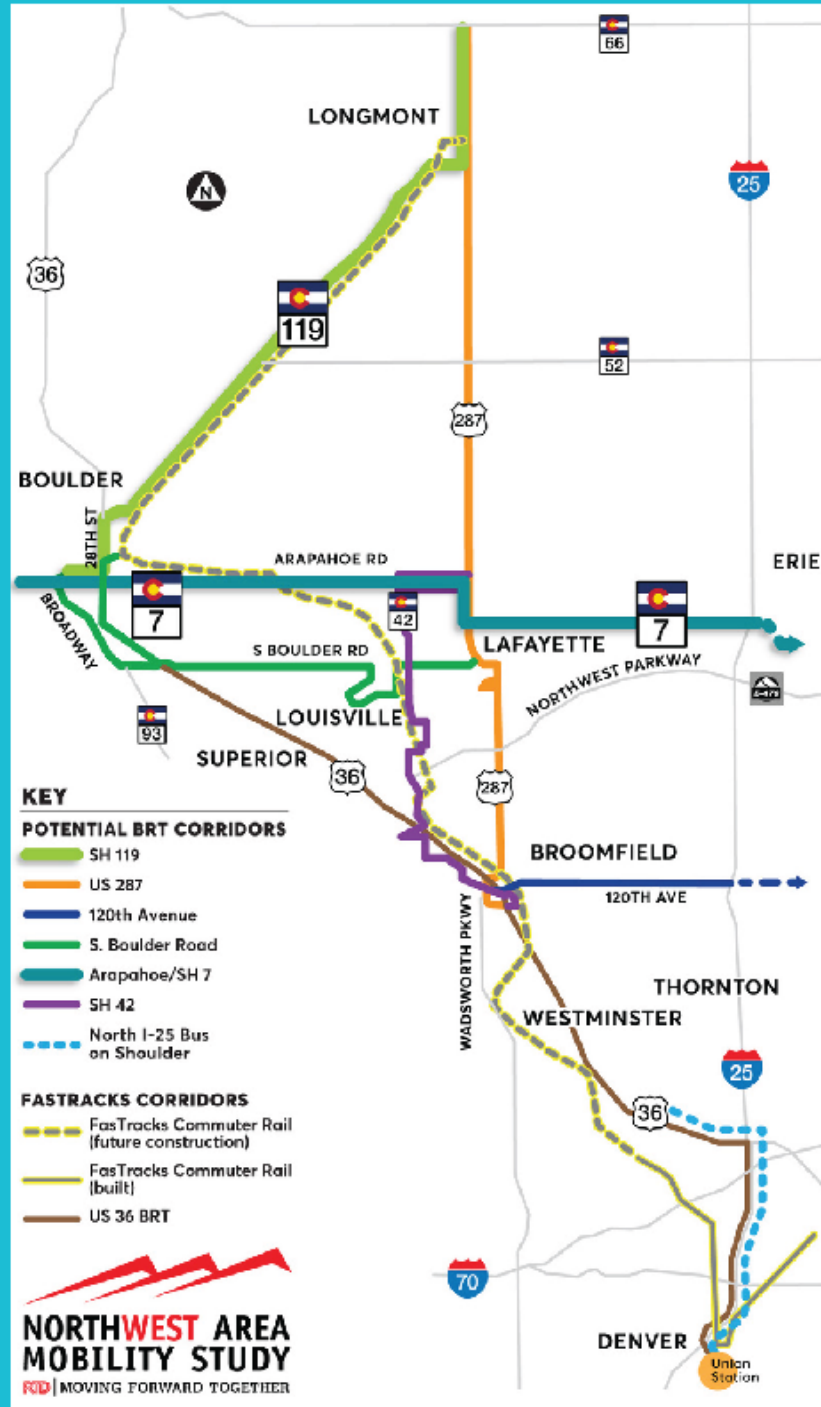
# Northwest Mayors & Commissioners Coalition

- The Northwest Mayors & Commissioners Coalition (MCC) was founded in 1999 and is a coalition of local governments in the northwest metro region.
- Speak with one voice regarding regional transportation investment priorities.
- Retain federal and state lobbyists.
- The MCC has support from all city councils, trustees and commissioners for the Northwest Area Mobility Study (NAMS) recommendations.
- In 2020, the MCC traveled to Washington DC to lobby for regional projects across the northwest metro region

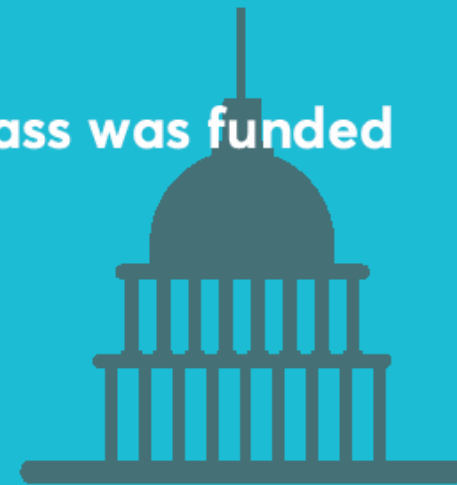


# Northwest Area Mobility Study (NAMS) Progress in 2020

- RTD Completed Planning and Environmental Linkage (PEL) Study on SH 119; CDOT committed an additional \$40 million for a total of committed funding of \$93 million
- SH 7: Brighton to Boulder studies completed; \$10 million in funding identified to initiate corridor design
- Explored Northwest Rail peak service from Longmont to Denver with RTD
- Quiet zone railroad safety crossing progress from Westminster to Longmont
- US 36 Bikeway/Sheridan Boulevard Underpass was funded

# NAMS Priorities for 2021

- Pursue federal, state, regional and local funding for SH 119 and SH 7 including applying for a US DOT BUILD Grant for SH 119
- Engage in legislative session discussions about other potential funding mechanisms
- Support successful implementation of SB 260 to advance NAMS priorities
- Continue to explore peak service for Northwest Rail
- Complete SH 119 First and Final Mile Study
- Begin the planning processes for US 287, 120th Avenue and SH 42
