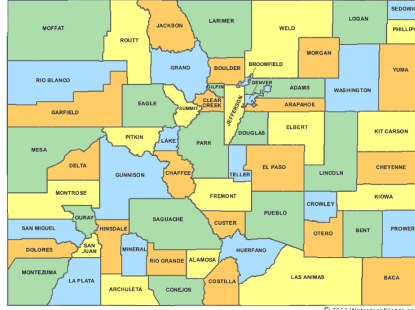

## SIPA Serves All of Colorado

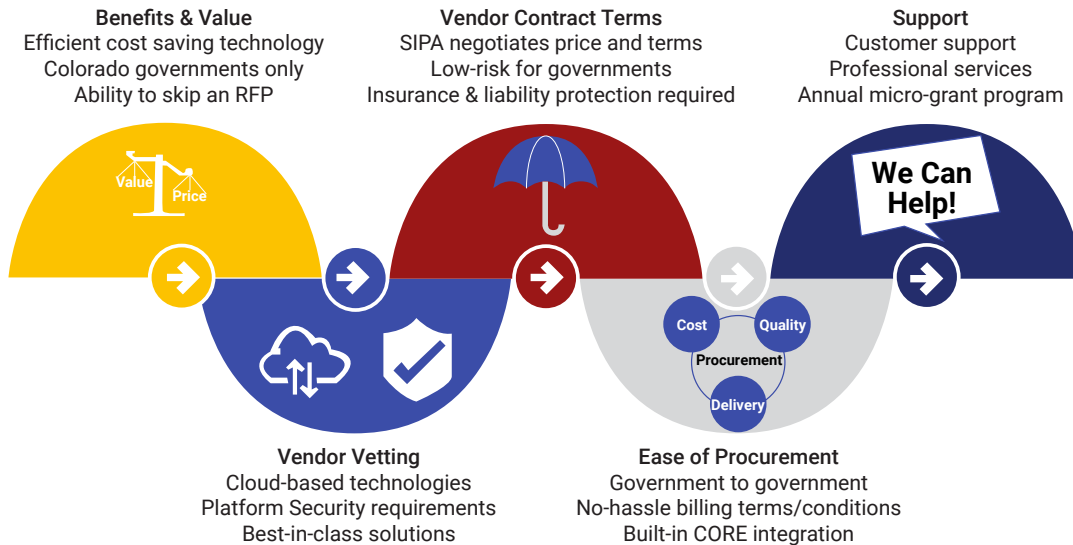


## Purpose Statement

SIPA is self-funded and no tax dollars are received for operations. Portal fees fund no-cost portal solutions, security, credit card equipment, and special projects. SIPA and its portal integrator employ nearly 50 people in Colorado.

## Mission

The Statewide Internet Portal Authority is to provide efficient and effective services for citizens through the use of modern business practices and innovative technology solutions. SIPA was created in 2004 under Senate Bill 04-244 (C.R.S. § 24-37.7-101 et seq.)

## Goals

- To continue development of a statewide internet portal to give members of the public an effective and efficient way to transact business.
- To increase the number of applications developed, integrated, and made publicly available on the portal by government entities
- To continue the micro-grant program to accelerate adoption of online services for constituents
- To increase the number of eligible government entities that use SIPA services through promotion and education
- To explore and expand the type of products, services, and solutions offered to governmental entities through SIPA

## Vision

The Statewide Internet Portal Authority is to transform Colorado government service delivery through the use of technology, allowing a single point of contact for members of the public to access state and local government information, products, and services.

## Portal Integrator

The portal integrator is contracted and managed by SIPA to provide no-cost solutions. The portal integrator operates under the umbrella of NIC USA, that provides services in 27 other states.
