

Trusted Interoperability Platform Alignment with Existing State Interoperability Efforts

Every dollar spent by one agency augments dollars spent by another agency.

CDPS administered Bureau of Justice Assistance Justice Reinvestment Initiative grant for \$1,250,000 – Creates pilot jail site connections

DHS administered Joint Agency Interoperability Platform (JAI) development funded through Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services

TIP will rely on OeHI's Health Information Governance Guidebook, Identity Resolution, Master Provider Index, Master Patient Index, Information Access Governance, and Patient Electronic Consent

BJA JRI Grant effort to develop common programming needs codes to support continuity of care across criminal justice agencies

OIT Broadband has ARPA funds to increase connectivity in rural areas

OBH Jail Based Behavioral Health Services ensure treatment can be provided when needs are identified

HB19-1297 and HB21-1211 created jail reporting requirements that can be automated

Colorado's four HUD-designated Continuums of Care administered HUD Homeless Management Information System (HMIS) - an information technology system used to collect client-level data and data on the provision of housing and services to homeless, as well as providing a streamlined approach to referrals, intakes and assessment across the entire service delivery system

Integrate Health Care Information and Health Care Providers Into the Trusted Interoperability Information Exchange



OBH funds will connect Community Mental Health Centers to the (S)HIEs – This will facilitate continuity of care upon release from jails and prisons

Social Health Information Exchanges (CCMCN, QHN & CORHIO) OeHI funding to support Social Health Information Exchange and Community Care Coordination to community agencies and community resource inventories

HCPF care coordination resources and incentives around transitions of care

OBH Medication Consistency initiative to help jails create access to HIEs
