## A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING LIMITING ACCESS TO JUVENILE RECORDS ON THE SEX 102 OFFENDER REGISTRY TO LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES.

## **Bill Summary**

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. Legislative Oversight Committee Concerning the Treatment of Persons with Mental Health Disorders in the Criminal and Juvenile Justice Systems. The bill limits access to information concerning the records of juveniles who are on the sex offender registry (juveniles on the registry) to law enforcement agencies only. Information concerning the records of juveniles on the registry shall not be:

- Released pursuant to a request for a criminal history record check;
- Posted on the website hosted by the Colorado bureau of investigation or a local law enforcement agency; or
- Released by a local law enforcement agency to any person residing within or outside of the local law enforcement agency's jurisdiction.
- Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:
- 2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 16-22-102, amend
- 3 (1); and **add** (1.5) and (4.2) as follows:

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- 4 **16-22-102. Definitions.** As used in this article 22, unless the context otherwise requires:
  - (1) "Birthday" means a person's birthday as reflected on the notice provided to the person pursuant to section 16-22-106 or 16-22-107 or the person's actual date of birth if the notice does not reflect the person's birthday "Adjudicated" or "Adjudication" means a determination by the court that it has been proven beyond a reasonable doubt to the trier of fact that a juvenile has committed a delinquent act or that a juvenile has pled guilty to committing a delinquent act. In addition, when a previous conviction must be pled and proven as an element of an offense or for purposes of sentence enhancement, "Adjudication" means conviction.
  - (1.5) "BIRTHDAY" MEANS A PERSON'S BIRTHDAY AS REFLECTED ON THE NOTICE PROVIDED TO THE PERSON PURSUANT TO SECTION 16-22-106 OR 16-22-107 OR THE PERSON'S ACTUAL DATE OF BIRTH IF THE NOTICE DOES NOT REFLECT THE PERSON'S BIRTHDAY.
- 20 (4.2) "JUVENILE" MEANS A PERSON WHO IS UNDER EIGHTEEN YEARS OF AGE AT THE TIME OF THE OFFENSE.
- 22 **SECTION 2.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 16-22-109, **amend**

14	SECTION 3. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 16-22-110, amend
15	(6)(a), (6)(b), and (6)(c) as follows:

18	(6) (a) The general assembly hereby recognizes the need to balance the
19	expectations of persons convicted of offenses involving unlawful sexual
20	behavior and the public's need to adequately protect themselves and their
21	children from these persons POTENTIAL HARM OF PUBLIC REGISTRATION
22	TO PERSONS OR JUVENILES CONVICTED OR ADJUDICATED OF OFFENSES
23	INVOLVING UNLAWFUL SEXUAL BEHAVIOR AND THE PUBLIC'S NEED TO BE
24	ADEQUATELY INFORMED, SO THAT THE PUBLIC MIGHT PROTECT
25	THEMSELVES AND THEIR CHILDREN FROM POTENTIAL HARM CAUSED BY
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	PERSONS WHO MIGHT REOFFEND, as expressed in section 16-22-112 (1).

concerning persons convicted of offenses involving unlawful sexual behavior available to the public, it is not the general assembly's intent that the information be used to inflict retribution or additional punishment on any person OR JUVENILE convicted OR ADJUDICATED of unlawful sexual behavior or of another offense, the underlying factual basis of which involves unlawful sexual behavior.

- (b) Pursuant to a request for a criminal history RECORD check under the provisions of part 3 of article 72 of title 24, C.R.S., UNLESS THE PERSON WHO IS THE SUBJECT OF THE CRIMINAL HISTORY RECORD CHECK IS A JUVENILE, the CBI may inform the requesting party as to whether the SUCH person who is the subject of the criminal history check is on the sex offender registry. If SUCH PERSON IS A JUVENILE, THE CBI SHALL NOT RELEASE SUCH INFORMATION TO A PERSON OR ENTITY OTHER THAN A LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY.
  - (c) A person may request from the CBI a list of persons on the sex offender registry, WHICH LIST MUST NOT INCLUDE JUVENILE OFFENDERS.
- **SECTION 4.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 16-22-111, **amend** (1) introductory portion as follows:

## **16-22-111.** Internet posting of sex offenders - procedure.

(1) The CBI shall post a link on the state of Colorado home page on the internet to a list containing the names, addresses, and physical descriptions of certain persons and descriptions of the offenses committed by said persons. A person's physical description shall MUST include, but need not be limited to, the person's sex, height, and weight; any identifying characteristics of the person; and a digitized photograph or image of the person. The list shall MUST specifically exclude any reference to any victims of the offenses. The list shall MUST SPECIFICALLY

EXCLUDE JUVENILE OFFENDERS BUT MUST	include the following persons:
EXCECTED TO THE OUT ENDERS BOT MOST	merade the following persons.

**SECTION 5.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 16-22-112, **amend** (1), (2)(a), (2)(b), and (3)(b) as follows:

**16-22-112. Release of information - law enforcement agencies - legislative declaration.** (1) (a) The general assembly finds that persons convicted of offenses involving unlawful sexual behavior have a reduced expectation of privacy because of the public's interest in public safety. The general assembly further finds that the public must have access to information concerning persons convicted of offenses involving unlawful sexual behavior that is collected pursuant to this **article** ARTICLE 22 to allow them to adequately protect themselves and their children from these persons.

- (b) The general assembly declares, however, that, in making this information available to the public, as provided in this section and section 16-22-110 (6), it is not the general assembly's intent that the information be used to inflict retribution or additional punishment on any person OR JUVENILE convicted OR ADJUDICATED of unlawful sexual behavior or of another offense, the underlying factual basis of which involves unlawful sexual behavior.
- (2) (a) A local law enforcement agency shall release information regarding any person, EXCEPT FOR A JUVENILE, registered with the local law enforcement agency pursuant to this article ARTICLE 22 to any person residing within the local law enforcement agency's jurisdiction. In addition, the local law enforcement agency may post the information specified in paragraph (b) of this subsection (2) SUBSECTION (2)(b) OF THIS SECTION on the law enforcement agency's website.
  - (b) A local law enforcement agency may post on its website sex

18	(III) A juvenile with a second or subsequent adjudication
19	involving unlawful sexual behavior or for a crime of violence as defined
20	in section 18-1.3-406, C.R.S.; or
21	(IV) A juvenile who is required to register pursuant to section
22	16-22-103 because he or she was adjudicated for an offense that would
23	have been a felony if committed by an adult and has failed to register as
24	required by section 16-22-103.
25	(3) (b) At its discretion, a local law enforcement agency may
26	release information regarding any person, EXCEPT FOR A JUVENILE,
27	registered with the local law enforcement agency pursuant to this article

1	ARTICLE 22 to any person who does not reside within the local law
2	enforcement agency's jurisdiction or may post the information specified
3	in paragraph (b) of subsection (2) SUBSECTION (2)(b) of this section on
4	the law enforcement agency's website. If a local law enforcement agency
5	does not elect to release information regarding any person registered with
6	the local law enforcement agency to a person not residing within the local
7	law enforcement agency's jurisdiction, the local law enforcement agency
8	may submit a request from the person to the CBI.
9	SECTION 6. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,
10	determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
11	preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
