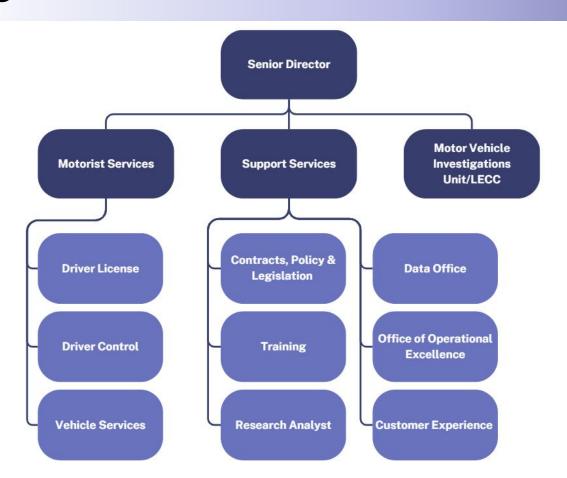

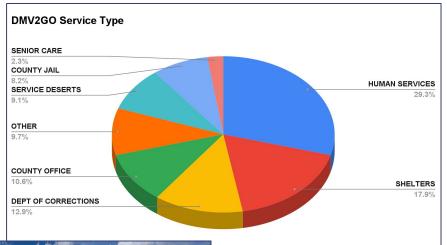

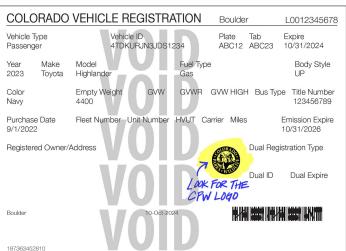

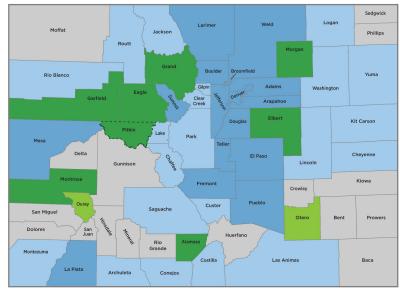

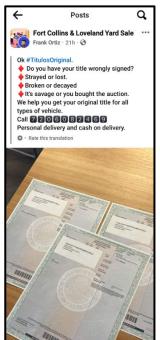
2025 DMV Proposed Legislation



Fraud Prevention and Mitigation

- Protecting DMV Official Products/Documents
 - Prohibiting the reproduction of DMV work products without express written consent from the issuing motor vehicle agency or if expressly authorized by law and adding civil penalties.
- Strengthen DMV Powers of Attorney
 - DMV produces two different POA forms for motor vehicle transactions
 - DMV requests the Uniform Power of Attorney Act apply to these POAs





2025 DMV Proposed Legislation



Customer Experience and Accessibility

- Minor Driving Log
 - Change eligibility to sign minor driving log to "any responsible adult" allowed to supervise minor driving
- Nurse Practitioners and Medical Assessment Forms for Credential Issuance
 - Aligns definition of "medical professional" with existing statute to simplify form completion in rural communities with less access to licensed physicians

Statutory Clean-Up

- Effective Date Consolidation of SB24-182 Immigrant ID Issuance
 - Effective dates currently split between 2025 for modification of credential issuance requirements to non-lawfully present individuals and 2027 for expansion of "Exceptions Processing" program
 - After review, the DMV believes both can be accomplished by 2025
- Strike Retired Optional License Plates and GSLPs from Statute
