Juvenile's Accused of Sexual Offences

- District Attorney's Office- Reviewed recommendations from the white sheet and it has not been approved yet.
- On a juvenile misdemeanor sex offence for the courts to show discretion.
- Current Law- If you are charged in the first petition with unlawful sexual contact or indecent exposure as main charge no other felonies, at that point you can be exempted from the registry after and OSC.
- Make it a tool for law enforcement only. Juveniles are not added to the public registry even after they turn 18 years.
- Eliminating Mandatory lifetime Registration- At this time there is no law that states juveniles have to do a lifetime mandatory registration, it is only a concern.
- If the juvenile failed to complete court ordered tasks, they could be charged and have to register.

Subcommittee Updates & Potential Legislative Priorities for Bill Request

- Peggy- Working on resources to continue with the BGA grant. It still needs a pilot project and some specific planning. Working with office of eHealth innovation to further look at different project that are working with other information.
- Also working to define medication consistency use case that list all the existing resources statewide. She met with different states regarding this.
