AN ACT

CONCERNING THE REESTABLISHMENT OF THE ENERGY COUNCIL AS A JOINT GOVERNMENTAL AGENCY FOR PURPOSES OF INTERSTATE COOPERATION.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. 2-3-311 (2) (b), Colorado Revised Statutes, 1980 Repl. Vol., is RECREATED AND REENACTED, WITH AMENDMENTS, to read:

2-3-311. Interstate cooperation. (2) (b) THE ENERGY COUNCIL IS DECLARED TO BE A JOINT GOVERNMENTAL AGENCY OF THIS STATE AND OTHER STATES WHICH COOPERATE THROUGH IT. THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY IS AUTHORIZED TO PAY MEMBERSHIP FEES THEREIN FROM APPROPRIATIONS MADE TO THE LEGISLATIVE DEPARTMENT OF STATE GOVERNMENT.

SECTION 2. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
