**AN ACT**

**CONCERNING EXEMPTION OF CERTAIN EDUCATIONAL FLIGHT SERVICES FROM THE "PRIVATE OCCUPATIONAL EDUCATION ACT OF 1981".**

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

**SECTION 1.** 12-59-104 (1), Colorado Revised Statutes, 1991 Repl. Vol., is amended BY THE ADDITION OF THE FOLLOWING NEW PARAGRAPHS to read:

**12-59-104. Exemptions.** (1) The following educational institutions and educational services are exempt from the provisions of this article:

(n) FLIGHT SCHOOLS THAT ARE NOT CERTIFIED BY THE UNITED STATES VETERANS ADMINISTRATION;

(o) FLIGHT SCHOOLS AND FLIGHT INSTRUCTORS THAT DO NOT COLLECT ADVANCE TUITION OR FEES.

**SECTION 2. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby inds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
