AN ACT**CONCERNING PRACTICAL EXPERIENCE EARNED AS PART OF A PHARMACEUTICAL INTERNSHIP.**

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. 12-22-111 (1), Colorado Revised Statutes, 1991 Repl. Vol., is amended to read:

12-22-111. Internship. (1) (a) All applicants for licensure by examination shall obtain practical experience in the practice of pharmacy. The board shall establish standards necessary to qualify an applicant for the licensure examination and shall determine the necessary qualifications for a preceptor.

(b) (I) FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, "PRACTICE OF PHARMACY", AS DEFINED IN SECTION 12-22-102 (26), MAY INCLUDE UP TO THIRTY PERCENT OF THE REQUIRED HOURS OF PRACTICAL EXPERIENCE WITH A DRUG MANUFACTURER UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF SUCH MANUFACTURER OR WITH A SCHOOL OF PHARMACY IN DRUG OR DRUG RELATED RESEARCH ACTIVITIES.

(II) THE BOARD SHALL PROMULGATE RULES TO IMPLEMENT THIS PARAGRAPH (b).

SECTION 2. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
