EDUCATION - PUBLIC SCHOOLS

AN ACT

CONCERNING THE EMPLOYMENT OF PROBATIONARY TEACHERS.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. 22-63-203 (2) (b) (II), Colorado Revised Statutes, is amended to read:

22-63-203. Probationary teachers - renewal and nonrenewal of employment contract. (2) (b) For purposes of paragraph (a) of this subsection (2):

(II) A probationary teacher who is employed after the first day of the academic year is deemed to be employed for a full school year if the period of continuous and uninterrupted employment during that year includes the last *minety* ONE HUNDRED TWENTY school days of the academic year.

SECTION 2. Effective date. This act shall take effect July 1, 1999.

SECTION 3. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
