**EDUCATION - UNIVERSITIES AND COLLEGES**

**SENATE BILL 99-200**

**AN ACT**

CONCERNING THE PROHIBITION ON THE COLORADO SCHOOL OF MINES' LEASING PROPERTY TO SOCIAL ORGANIZATIONS.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

**SECTION 1. Repeal.** 23-41-104 (7), Colorado Revised Statutes, is repealed as follows:

~~**23-41-104. Control - management.** (7) Nothing in subsections (2), (3), and (4) of this section shall constitute any authority to lease any portions of college grounds to any fraternity, sorority, or other social organization.~~

**SECTION 2. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
