AN ACT

CONCERNING THE AUTHORITY OF THE COLORADO BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION TO APPREHEND FUGITIVES.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. 24-33.5-412 (1), Colorado Revised Statutes, is amended BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW PARAGRAPH to read:

- **24-33.5-412. Functions of bureau legislative review.** (1) The bureau has the following authority:
 - (q) TO LOCATE AND APPREHEND PERSONS WHO ARE FUGITIVES FROM THE LAW.
- **SECTION 2.** No appropriation. The general assembly has determined that this act can be implemented within existing appropriations, and therefore no separate appropriation of state moneys is necessary to carry out the purposes of this act.
- **SECTION 3. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
