**SENATE BILL 03-071**

**AN ACT****CONCERNING THE PREREQUISITES FOR THE ISSUANCE OF LIQUOR LICENSES TO CERTAIN TYPES OF PREMISES.**

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

**SECTION 1.** 12-47-307 (1) (b) (II), Colorado Revised Statutes, is amended to read:

**12-47-307. Persons prohibited as licensees.** (1) (b) (II) With respect to ARTS OR club license applications, ~~by corporations only~~, an investigation of the character of the ~~corporate~~ president OR CHAIR OF THE BOARD and the ~~club~~ OPERATIONAL manager shall be deemed sufficient to determine whether to issue the ARTS OR club license to the ~~corporation~~ APPLICANT.

**SECTION 2.** 12-47-417 (2), Colorado Revised Statutes, is amended to read:

**12-47-417. Arts license.** (2) Any provision of this article to the contrary notwithstanding, the proximity of premises licensed pursuant to this section to any public or parochial school or the principal campus of ~~any~~ A college, university, or seminary shall not, in and of itself, affect the granting or denial of such license by the state and the local licensing authority, but ~~no such school or campus~~ A PUBLIC OR PAROCHIAL SCHOOL shall NOT contain a licensed premises. THE CAMPUS OF A COLLEGE, UNIVERSITY, OR SEMINARY MAY CONTAIN A LICENSED PREMISES.

**SECTION 3. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
