AN ACT**CONCERNING THE CONTINUATION OF THE STATEWIDE PILOT PROGRAM FOR TEEN PREGNANCY AND DROPOUT PREVENTION.**

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. 26-4-804, Colorado Revised Statutes, is amended to read:

26-4-804. Reports. The department shall provide ~~reports~~ A REPORT to the general assembly ~~no later than July 1, 1997, and~~ no later than September 1, ~~2002~~ 2005, demonstrating the effectiveness of the pilot program and evaluating whether the pilot program should be continued.

SECTION 2. 26-4-805, Colorado Revised Statutes, is amended to read:

26-4-805. Repeal of part. This part 8 is repealed, effective July 1, ~~2003~~ 2006.

SECTION 3. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
