AN ACT

**CONCERNING THE AUTHORITY OF MEMBERS-ELECT TO SERVE ON THE CAPITAL DEVELOPMENT
COMMITTEE.**

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. 2-3-1302 (1.5), Colorado Revised Statutes, is amended to read:

2-3-1302. Capital development committee established. (1.5) In order to expedite the work of the capital development committee, appointees may be designated after the general election prior to the convening of the general assembly at which such committee is to serve, ~~provided that~~ WHETHER such appointees are members of the current general assembly OR MEMBERS-ELECT OF THE NEXT GENERAL ASSEMBLY, OR BOTH. Such appointees have all the powers and duties and are entitled to the same compensation and expense allowance as members duly appointed under the provisions of subsection (1) of this section.

SECTION 2. Effective date. This act shall take effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly that is allowed for submitting a referendum petition pursuant to article V, section 1 (3) of the state constitution, (August 8, 2007, if adjournment sine die is on May 9, 2007); except that, if a referendum petition is filed against this act or an item, section, or part of this act within such period, then the act, item, section, or part, if approved by the people, shall take effect on the date of the official declaration of the vote thereon by proclamation of the governor.
