AN ACT**CONCERNING THE COLLECTION OF FINES FROM STATE PARKS.**

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. 33-15-103 (1) (a), Colorado Revised Statutes, is amended to read:

33-15-103. Disposition of fines - notice of court decisions. (1) (a) All moneys collected for fines under this article and articles 10 to 13 and 32 of this title, either by payment of a penalty assessment or assessed by a court upon conviction, shall be transmitted to the state treasurer, who shall credit ~~one-half to the general fund and one-half~~ SUCH MONEYS to the parks and outdoor recreation cash fund; except that, when an arrest has been made or the citation for any offense, including those committed under article 14 of this title, has been issued by an officer of the division of wildlife, all moneys collected for the fine shall be transmitted to the state treasurer, who shall credit one-half to the wildlife cash fund and one-half to the general fund.

SECTION 2. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
