AN ACT

CONCERNING THE REMOVAL OF THE OFFICE OF THE STATE AUDITOR FROM THE GROUP OF LEGISLATIVE SERVICE AGENCIES REQUIRED TO CONDUCT POST-ENACTMENT REVIEWS OF THE IMPLEMENTATION OF BILLS UNDER SECTION 2-2-1201, COLORADO REVISED STATUTES.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. 2-2-1201 (7) (b), Colorado Revised Statutes, is amended to read:

2-2-1201. Accountability clauses - post-enactment review of implementation of bills by legislative service agencies - definitions. (7) For purposes of this section, unless the context otherwise requires:

(b) "Legislative service agencies" means the office of legislative legal services, legislative council staff, AND staff of the joint budget committee. ~~and office of the state auditor.~~

SECTION 2. Effective date - applicability. This act shall take effect July 1, 2008, and shall apply to the post-enactment review of legislation required in accordance with the provisions of part 12 of article 2 of title 2, Colorado Revised Statutes, before, on, or after said date.

SECTION 3. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
