AN ACT

CONCERNING MAIL ORDER PRESCRIPTION DRUGS FOR MEDICAID RECIPIENTS WHO HAVE THIRD-PARTY INSURANCE.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. 25.5-5-505 (1) (a) (I) (B), Colorado Revised Statutes, is amended to read:

- **25.5-5-505. Prescribed drugs mail order rules.** (1) (a) (I) The state board shall adopt by rule a system to allow the following medical assistance recipients to receive prescribed maintenance medications through mail order:
- (B) Recipients who have third-party insurance that requires ALLOWS the recipient to obtain maintenance medications through mail order.
- **SECTION 2. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
