AN ACT

CONCERNING PARTICIPATION IN THE ADDRESS CONFIDENTIALITY PROGRAM BY A PERSON WHO RESIDES WITH A VICTIM PARTICIPANT.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. 24-21-205 (3) (j), Colorado Revised Statutes, is amended to read:

24-21-205. Filing and certification of applications - authorization card.

(3) The application shall be on a form prescribed by the secretary of state and shall contain all of the following:

(j) The name of a ~~parent, spouse, dependent child, or other family member~~ ANY PERSON who resides with the applicant who also needs to be a program participant in order to ensure the safety of the applicant, and if the person named in the application is eighteen years of age or older, the consent of such person to be a program participant;

SECTION 2. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
