## AN ACT

## CONCERNING REQUESTS FOR MULTIPLE BOOKING PHOTOGRAPHS.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

**SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-72-305.5, **amend** (2) (b) as follows:

**24-72-305.5. Access to records - denial by custodian - use of records to obtain information for solicitation - definitions.** (2) (b) A person who requests a copy of ~~a~~ ONE OR MORE booking ~~photograph~~ PHOTOGRAPHS from an official custodian shall, at the time of making the request, submit the statement required by subsection (1) of this section; EXCEPT THAT A CUSTODIAN MAY ALLOW A PERSON WHO ANTICIPATES MAKING MULTIPLE REQUESTS FOR BOOKING PHOTOGRAPHS TO SUBMIT THE REQUIRED STATEMENT ONCE FOR ALL BOOKING PHOTOGRAPHS REQUESTED DURING A SPECIFIED PERIOD OF TIME NOT TO EXCEED ONE YEAR. By signing the statement, the person is affirming that ~~the~~ ANY booking photograph OBTAINED FROM THE CUSTODIAN will not be placed in a publication or posted to a web site that requires the payment of a fee or other exchange for pecuniary gain in order to remove or delete the booking photograph from the publication or web site.

**SECTION 2. Applicability.** This act applies to requests for photographs made on or after the effective date of this act.

**SECTION 3. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
