**Re:** Compliance with Statutory Requirements

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This written notification is being provided as required by Colorado Revised Statute (C.R.S.) §25-4-1607(14)(c), which states as follows:

“The executive director of the department shall notify the revisor of statutes, in writing, when the conditions specified in paragraphs (a) and (b) of this subsection

(14) have been satisfied.”

The paragraphs referenced in the statutory citation above refer back to two other statutes, §25-4-1607.7(2) and §25-4-1607.9(1), C.R.S., which state as follows:

#### §25-4-1607.7(2)

“After July 1, 2017, the department or a local public health agency contracted by the department to perform inspections and enforce regulations regarding retail food establishments shall only utilize the system developed and approved by the department to communicate inspection results.”

The Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment and the local public health agencies were in compliance with this requirement as of June 30, 2017.

#### §25-4-1607.9(1)

“On or before April 1, 2017, the department shall respond to all plans and specifications and HACCP plan reviews within fourteen working days after receipt, as required by section 25-4-1605 (4).”

The Department has been in compliance with this requirement since July 1, 2016.
