2	- required notice. (1) Each person who is required by 42 U.S.C. sec. 263b to provide a
3	patient, the patient's physician, or A medical institution with a mammography report and who
4	has determined that the patient has dense breast tissue, as determined by the interpreting
5	physician based on breast imaging reporting and data system standards promulgated by the
6	American College of Radiology, shall include the following notice with the mammography
7	report:
8	Your mammogram shows that your breast tissue is dense. Dense breast tissue
9	is common and is not abnormal. However, dense breast tissue can make it
10	harder to evaluate the results of your mammogram and may also be associated
11	with an increased risk of breast cancer. This information about the results of
12	your mammogram is given to you to raise your awareness and to inform your
13	conversations with your doctor. Together, you can decide which screening
14	options are right for you. A report of your results was sent to your physician.
15	(2) Notwithstanding any other law, this section does not create a cause of action or
16	create a standard of care, obligation, or duty that provides a basis for a cause of action.
