Text of Measure:

Be it Enacted by the People of Colorado:

SECTION 1. Legislative Declaration. THE PEOPLE OF COLORADO FIND AND DECLARE THAT EMPLOYEES OF PUBLIC SCHOOLS IN THE STATE OF COLORADO SHOULD HAVE A GREATER ABILITY TO ENSURE THAT THE COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT ENTERED INTO BY ANY ORGANIZATION THAT REPRESENTS THEM IS TRANSPARENT AND RESPONSIVE TO THEIR INTERESTS.

SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, **add** 22-32-109(3) as follows:

(3) ANY BOARD ENTERING INTO A COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT WITH EMPLOYEES OF THE DISTRICT AS DEFINED IN SECTION 22-32-109.4(2), C.R.S., SHALL ENSURE BY THE TERMS OF THE COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT THAT SUCH AGREEMENT IS APPROVED BY THE MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS OF ANY GROUP, ASSOCIATION OR ORGANIZATION REPRESENTED IN THE AGREEMENT AT LEAST ONCE EVERY TWO YEARS WITH AN ELECTION TO OCCUR IN THE MONTH OF OCTOBER OF EACH ELECTION YEAR, AS DEFINED IN C.R.S. § 22-31-104, AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS SUBSECTION (3);

SECTION 3. Effective date. January 1, 2018.
