Greetings and Salutations To:

Servants and Employees there of; Legislative Drafting Committee, you are here by requested by the Sovereign of the State and United States to perform your duties and functions according to Article V section 1 clause 5 Colorado Constitution to review and comment on the below or attached proposed initiative. Be it also requested pursuant to Title One Article Forty Parts One and Three. Colorado Revised Statutes to properly Draft the below measure to conform to constitutional requirements with suggested ballot title. Be it enacted.

Article XXI Section 5 Colorado Constitution

5. (a). Original Electronic Signature of Registered Voters may be used along with traditional original signatures of the registered electorate for Initiative and Referendum

(b). Authentication of Original Electronic Signatures is sufficient when the receiving website can show such signatures arose from a secured transaction, either by showing a secure programming code to secretary of state that demonstrates to the satisfaction of the secretary of state such site record is protected from adequate measures from inundation with false, unregistered or repeated signatures. Or as approved or recommended by the Secretary of State.

3.5. (c) The development of such codes or authentication process acceptable for use by law or pilot programs enacted by legislation must include and shall not exclude Total Recall Petition Drives for a period of eight years from adoption at the polls, for their initiative and/or sweat equity providing this Initiative is adopted at the Polls.
