Fiscal Summary of Initiative 222

This fiscal summary, prepared by the nonpartisan Director of Research of the Legislative Council, contains a preliminary assessment of the measure's fiscal impact. A full fiscal impact statement for this initiative is or will be available at leg.colorado.gov/bluebook. This fiscal summary identifies the following impact.

State expenditures. The measure specifies that only female students, based on their biological sex at birth, may participate in public athletics programs for minors that are designated for women, females, or girls. The Colorado School for the Deaf and the Blind, a state-run public school, is subject to the measure and may have minimal costs to implement its provisions.

Local government impact. The measure may increase expenditures for school districts, charter schools, and any local governments that offer public athletics programs for minors to update policies. Costs for public schools and local governments are expected to be minimal.

Economic impacts. The measure is not expected to have a significant or direct impact on the state's economy.
