Staff Recommendation: The staff recommendation for this request is pending Committee approval of common policy supplementals. Staff asks permission to include the corresponding appropriations in the Department's supplemental bill when the Committee approves this common policy supplemental. If staff believes there is reason to deviate from the common policy, staff will appear before the Committee later to present the relevant analysis.

Additional Information: Staff understands that the common policy recommendation will be to <u>not</u> make this adjustment, on the grounds that the Department will underspend the appropriation whether or not there is a change to the appropriation. Given the relatively small size of the anticipated reversion, there seems little benefit to making the requested adjustment in this department. If the Committee accepts this recommendation, there will be no supplemental bill for the Department of Local Affairs this year.
