SUBJECT JBC Bill Drafts Removal Request

As part of the process of potential legislation, JBC staff have reviewed the potential legislation list and recommend that some of the potential legislation be removed. Staff recommendation is that these items be removed from consideration this session and addressed in future years as appropriate.

This bill would require General Fund above the \$120.9 million increase already approved for the Governing Boards. In light of the many demands on the General Fund for FY 2019-20, staff no longer recommends attempting to fund this program this year.
108 and 111		Labor and Employment	TABOR impact - Bill to clarify management of Employment Support Fund	Staff	Bickel	This was originally estimated to provide \$10 million positive GF revenue impact associated with the TABOR impact in FY 19 and FY 20. However, the Legislative Council Staff forecast adopted by the Committee does not project TABOR taxpayer refunds for FY 2018-19 or FY 2019-20 and therefore no General Fund impact is expected from this bill at present. Staff still believes that the Employment Support Fund statute should be modified. However, this could be delayed to the 2020 session.
