Request/Recommendation Descriptions

NPS1 ALJ services adjustment: The request includes an increase of \$634 reappropriated funds from indirect cost recoveries for the midyear administrative law judge services (ALJ services) adjustment. This request item was addressed during the JBC staff supplemental presentation for the Department of Personnel on January 8, 2015. **Staff requests permission to incorporate the Committee's action into the supplemental bill.** Note the dollar amounts in the table represent the requested appropriation change.

NPS2 Capitol Complex adjustment: The request includes an increase of \$2,771 reappropriated funds from indirect cost recoveries for the midyear Capitol Complex adjustment. This request item was addressed during the JBC staff supplemental presentation for the Department of Personnel on January 8, 2015. **Staff requests permission to incorporate the Committee's action into the supplemental bill.** Note the dollar amounts in the table represent the requested appropriation change.

NPS3 Fleet adjustment: The request includes an increase of \$21,671 federal funds for the midyear fleet adjustment. This request item was addressed during the JBC staff supplemental presentation for the Department of Personnel on January 8, 2015. **Staff requests permission to incorporate the Committee's action into the supplemental bill.** Note the dollar amounts in the table represent the requested appropriation change.

NPS4 CORE adjustment: The request includes a reduction of \$586,873 reappropriate funds from indirect cost recoveries for the midyear CORE adjustment. This request item was addressed during the JBC staff supplemental presentation for the Department of Personnel on January 8, 2015. **Staff requests permission to incorporate the Committee's action into the supplemental bill.** Note the dollar amounts in the table represent the requested appropriation change.

FRAPPE interim supplemental: The Department requested spending authority for \$1.3 million total funds, of which \$351,000 is General Fund, to pay contract costs related to the Front Range Air Pollution and Photochemistry Experiment (FRAPPE) in FY 2014-15. The dollars that were requested were appropriated but not expended in FY 2013-14 due to the timing of contract payments. The Committee approved the request at the September 2014 meeting, for an appropriation of \$351,000 General Fund and \$949,000 cash funds from the Stationary Sources Cash Fund for FY 2014-15. The recommendation included adding a footnote to the appropriate line item limiting the use of these dollars for FRAPPE expenditures.

Prioritized Supplemental Requests

The Department did not submit any FY 2014-15 prioritized supplementals.

Non-prioritized Supplemental Requests - Statewide Common Policy Supplemental Requests

These requests are not prioritized and are not analyzed in this packet. The JBC acted on these items during the January 8, 2015 supplemental presentation for the Department of Personnel. For all common policies staff requests permission to adjust the line items based on the Committee's actions.
