Staff recommends that the Committee:

1. Include an increase of \$378.5 million General Fund Exempt (GFE) appropriation and a decrease of \$378.5 million General Fund (GF) for FY 2012-13. The recommendation for FY 2012-13 is based on the State Auditor's Schedule of Computations Required Under Article X, Section 20, of the State Constitution (TABOR) dated February 2014 that indicates the GFE for FY 2012-13 was \$1,859,874,521. The following Table reflects the adjustments that need to be made to GFE appropriations for FY 2012-13:
