**Staff Analysis:** The supplemental budget request corrects the appropriation in the Department's budget for FY 2012-13 in order to match the appropriation set in the Department of Human Services budget. This appropriation is funded by the Colorado Disabled Telephone Users Fund created in Section 40-17-104 (1), C.R.S., and paid pursuant to Section 40-17-104 (4) (a), C.R.S.

**Staff Recommendation:** Staff recommends that the Committee approve a \$1,535 increase in cash funds for the *Transfer to CAPCO Administration* line item in the Division of Insurance for FY 2012-13.

**Staff Analysis:** The supplemental budget request corrects the appropriation in the Department's budget for FY 2012-13 in order to match the appropriation set in the Office of the Governor's budget. This appropriation is funded by the Division of Insurance Cash Fund created in Section 10-1-103 (3), C.R.S., and paid pursuant to Section 24-48.5-106 (3), C.R.S.

**Summary:** The Committee approved this supplemental in September 2012 when the Department requested \$265,104 cash fund spending authority and 2.0 FTE from the Division of Real Estate Cash Fund, \$62,839 reappropriated funds and 0.5 FTE for the Department of Law for the provision of legal services, and \$23,700 cash funds from the Colorado Bureau of Investigation Identification Unit Fund for fingerprint-based criminal history checks, for the implementation of H.B. 12-1110, for FY 2012-13. The Department's additional line item appropriations include \$62,839 cash funds for *Legal Services* and \$100,000 cash funds for *Purchase of Services from Computer Center* in the Executive Director's Office and \$90,959 cash funds and 2.0 FTE for Personal Services and \$11,306 cash funds for Operating Expenses in the Division of Real Estate.

House Bill 12-1110 was passed by the General Assembly and signed by the Governor on June 8, 2012. Section 18 of the bill is the appropriations clause that appropriates the equivalent of the Department's 1331 request for FY 2012-13 for the purpose of implementing the bill. Section 19 of the bill is the effective date clause stating the effective date of the bill as July 1, 2013. The effective date clause as included in the bill serves to nullify the General Assembly's intended appropriation for FY 2012-13.

During the legislative process, staff failed to identify the effective date clause as problematic for the intended appropriation that would provide the resources to the Departments of Regulatory Agencies, Law, and Public Safety to ready the program, including rulemaking and information system changes, and have it in place by the General Assembly's intended start date for the regulatory provisions that take effect on July 1, 2013.

The rules governing interim supplementals in Section 24-75-111 (5), C.R.S., require the Committee to introduce all interim supplementals that it approves. Staff will include this supplemental in the Department's supplemental bill.
