Article 29.3—Uniform Emergency Volunteer Health Practitioners Act

OLLS proposed that Article 29.3 be relocated. Proposed new locations for it are Title 25, as that title relates to CDPHE, or a new part in Article 33.5 of Title 24. (Part 7 of Article 33.5 of Title 24 relates to disaster management, which triggers the Uniform Emergency Volunteer Health Practitioners Act.)

Betsy Murray remarked that it would be nice to have all health care professionals in one title. She expressed concern about difficulty for consumers and practitioners in locating pertinent laws. So, even though it is administered by CDPHE, it would be ideal to retain regulation of health care professionals in Title 12.

Alternatively, if it is moved out of Title 12, then Ms. Murray suggested that we have a section in Title 12 that cross-references the other title in which the new article is located. That way, a person who looks at Title 12 for a regulated profession could easily find it even if it is located elsewhere.

Article 30—Cancer Cure Control

OLLS suggested that Article 30 is a candidate for relocation. Proposed new locations are as a new Part 26 in Article 4 of Title 25, because that article relates to disease control, or as a new article in Title 25.

Jenny Willits expressed no strong opinion at this point, although she could see keeping it in Title 12, since it relates to the medical profession. But since CDPHE has governance, it probably makes more sense to go in Title 25. She will get back to us with additional feedback.
