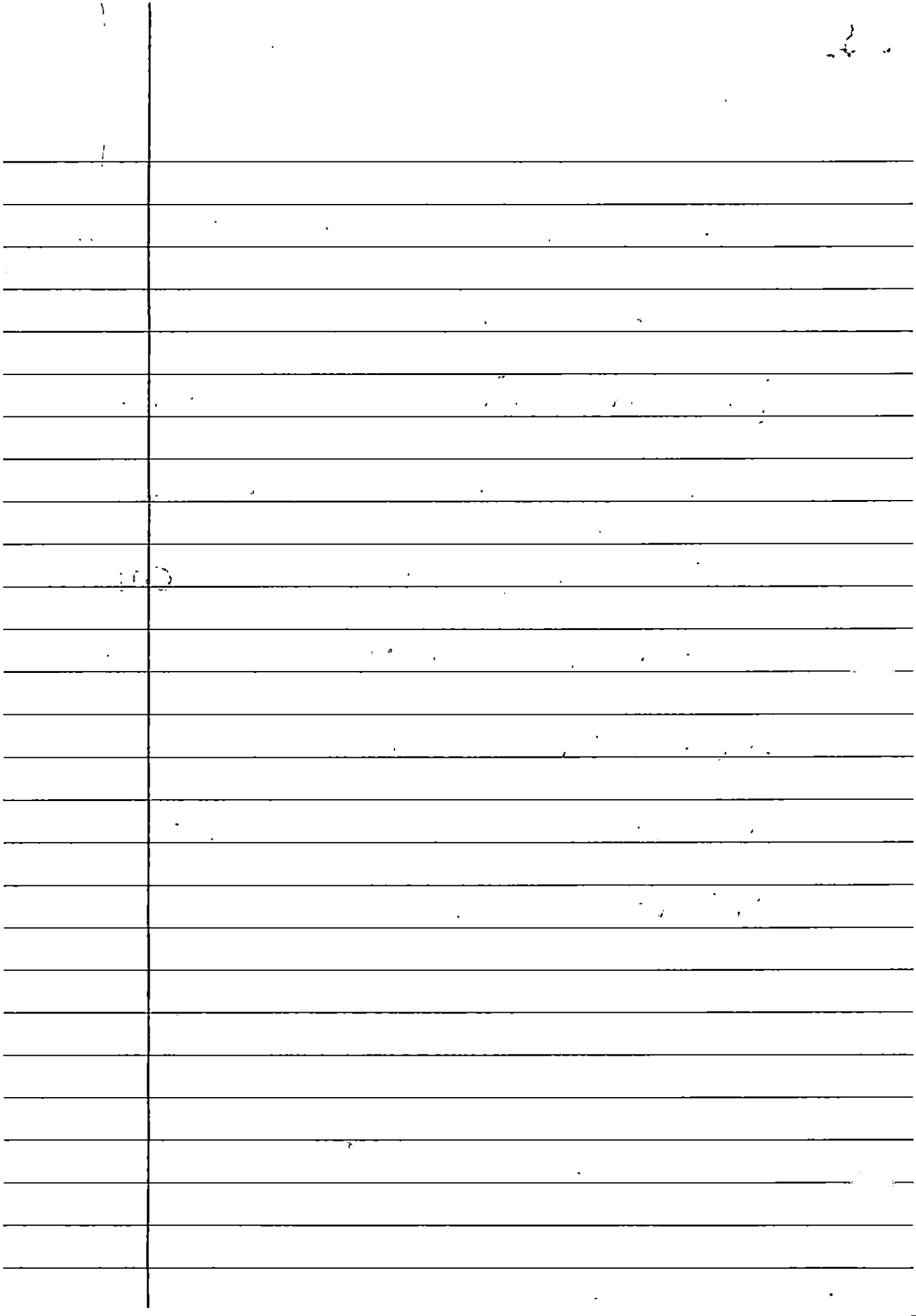

parents as well as their children

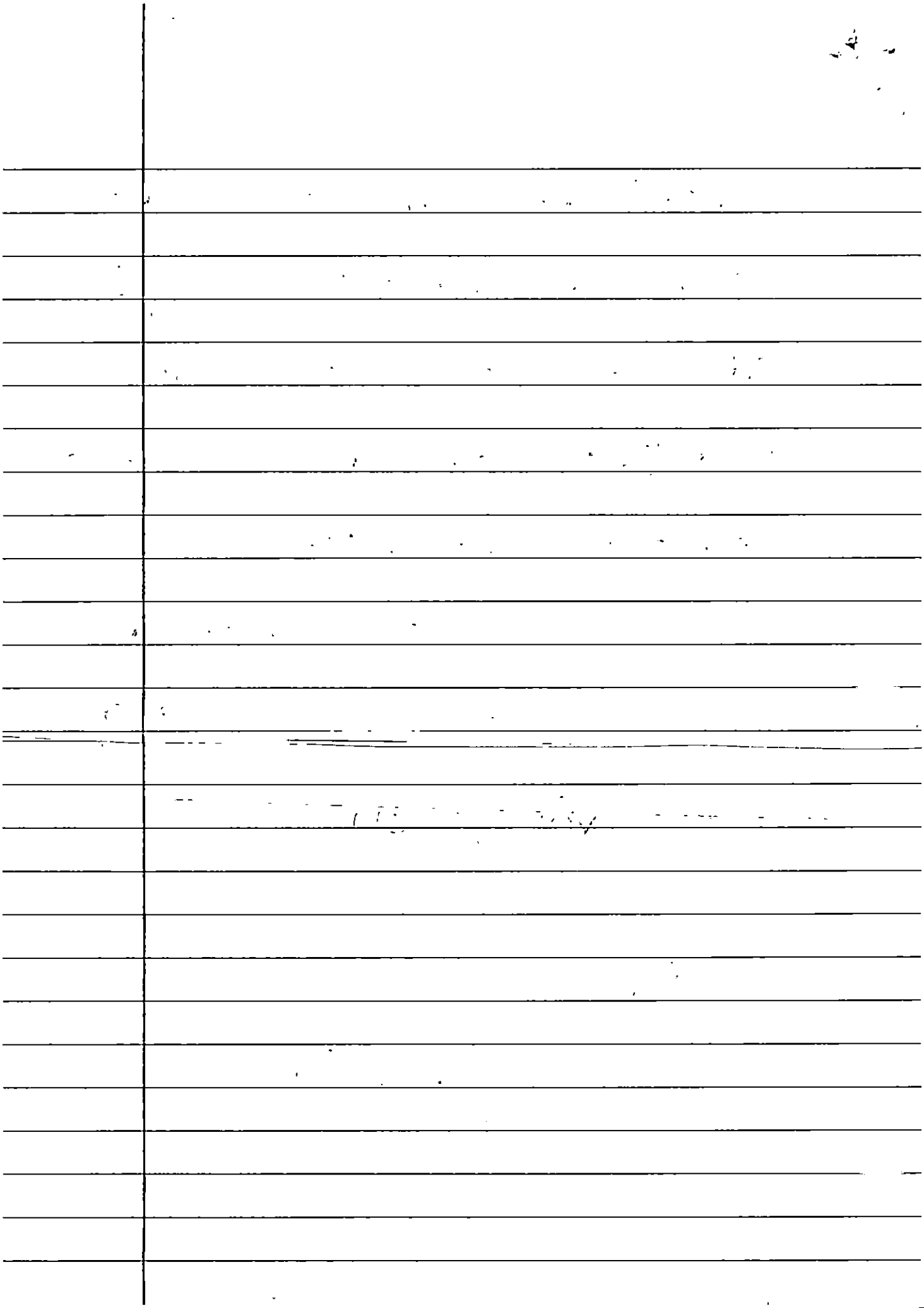
