SENATE COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE AMENDMENT

Committee on State, Veterans, & Military Affairs.SB20-105 be amended as follows:

1 Amend printed bill, page 2, strike lines 2 through 25.

2 Strike page 3 and substitute:

3 "SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 2-4-109, amend (1)
4 and (2); and add (1.5) as follows:

5 2-4-109. Standard time - daylight saving time - repeal.
6 (1) (a) The standard time within the state, except as provided in
7 subsection (2) of this section, is that which is now known and designated
8 by act of congress as "United States Mountain Standard Time".

9 (b) THIS SUBSECTION (1) IS REPEALED, EFFECTIVE ON THE DATE
10 SUBSECTION (1.5) OF THIS SECTION BECOMES EFFECTIVE.

11 (1.5) (a) THE STANDARD TIME WITHIN THE STATE IS COORDINATED
12 UNIVERSAL TIME MINUS SEVEN HOURS.

13 (b) THIS SUBSECTION (1.5) IS EFFECTIVE ON THE EARLIER OF:

14 (I) THE DAY BEFORE THE ENACTMENT OF THE "SUNSHINE
15 PROTECTION ACT OF 2019," S.670 IN THE ONE HUNDRED SIXTEENTH
16 CONGRESS OF THE UNITED STATES; OR

17 (II) ON THE FIRST SUNDAY IN NOVEMBER FOLLOWING THE
18 ENACTMENT OF A FEDERAL LAW THAT REPEALS THE ADVANCEMENT OF
19 TIME CURRENTLY SET FORTH IN 15 U.S.C. SEC. 260a (a) AND ALLOWS THE
20 STATE TO REMAIN ON THE TIME CURRENTLY KNOWN AS "UNITED STATES
21 MOUNTAIN STANDARD TIME" YEAR-ROUND.

22 (2) (a) From two o'clock antemeridian on the second Sunday of
23 March, until two o'clock antemeridian on the first Sunday of November,
24 or such other times and days as may, from time to time, be designated by
25 act of congress, the standard time in this state so established shall be one
26 hour in advance of the standard time now known as "United States
27 Mountain Standard Time".

28 (b) THIS SUBSECTION (2) IS REPEALED, EFFECTIVE ON THE DATE
29 SUBSECTION (1.5) OF THIS SECTION BECOMES EFFECTIVE.

30 SECTION 2. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,
31 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
32 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety."
