## The Issue

- Current statute does not allow out of state students to participate on the State Student Advisory Council (SSAC).
- This requirement stops hundreds of students across Colorado from becoming SSAC members and leaders on their college campus.
- Creates a barrier to equity and inclusion and limits representation.

## Proposed Legislation

- Eliminate the in-state requirement as a condition of membership in SSAC.

- Increased range of perspectives, experiences, and voices from students across the state who can advocate on behalf of their fellow peers.
