Protection Orders

- ◆ Current Protection orders don't necessarily remove fire arms from the restrained person.

The Court Finds it is appropriate to issue this Protection Order pursuant to §18-1-1001, C.R.S.

The Court Finds that the Defendant is is not governed by the Brady Handgun Violence Prevention Act (d)(8) and (g)(8).

Therefore, it is ordered that you, the Defendant:

1. Shall not harass, molest, intimidate, retaliate against, or tamper with any witness to or charged with committing.
2. Shall vacate the home of the victim(s), stay away from the home of the victim(s), and location the victim(s) is/are likely to be found.
3. Shall refrain from contacting or directly or indirectly communicating with the victim(s) or v
4. Shall not possess, purchase, or control a firearm or other weapon.
5. Shall not possess or purchase any ammunition. Wasn't enforced
6. Shall relinquish, for the duration of the order, any firearm or ammunition in your immediate subject to your immediate possession or control, and shall do so within 24 (hours) (24 or 24 (24 hours or up to 5 days) for ammunition. If you are in custody and cannot relinquish the court orders you to do so within 24 hours of your release from custody. You shall file with the court, within 3 business days of the relinquishment as required by statute.
7. Shall not possess or consume alcoholic beverages or controlled substances.
8. Is further ordered that:

THE DEFENDANT HAVE NO CONTACT WITH ANY VICTIM LISTED EXCEPT THROUGH THE DEFENDANT'S COUNSEL OR AGENTS OF COUNSEL.

This Order remains in effect until final disposition or further order of the court.
