Per the Colorado Courts e-filing system instructions and given the fact Denver District and Denver County Courts have at various times done or claimed all of the following:

- 1) Repeatedly threatened plaintiff with arrest and chased Plaintiff out of the courthouses when she attempts to file and/or retrieve records and conduct court business in person, including filing court records.
