Dear Representative Duran, Representative Carver, Senator Rodriguez, and Senator Holbert,

As we continue to monitor the progress of HB19-1167, we do not see anything in this bill that would prohibit Pavaso from doing business in Colorado. Pavaso has been approved as an eClosing Vendor offering Face to Face eNotarization as well Remote online eNotarization in all states that require approvals. We have successfully eNotarized thousands of documents with respect to the security and privacy of our consumers.

Through the use of our technology and audio video communication we do not sale, use, or transfer any of the personal information collected in the course of performing a notarial act.

Respecting the privacy of our customer's data, does not create challenges for Pavaso to do business in Colorado, rather Colorado's RON bill supports Pavaso's philosophy around the protection of data. Pavaso is in strong support of HB19-1167 as this bill will allow independent notaries in the state of Colorado to use our RON platform to conduct notarizations while protecting consumer data.
