HOUSE COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE AMENDMENT

Committee on Judiciary.HB18-1204 be amended as follows:

1 Amend printed bill, page 12, line 22, strike "(4)(c)" and substitute "(4)(a),
2 (4)(c),".

3 Page 12, strike line 24 and substitute "- **definition.** (4) (a) Any person
4 who violates the provisions of subsection (1), (2), or (3) of this section
5 commits a class 1 misdemeanor traffic offense; EXCEPT THAT THE PERSON
6 IS NOT SUBJECT TO IMPRISONMENT. The minimum fine imposed by section
7 42-4-1701 (3)(a)(II)(A) shall be IS mandatory, and the defendant shall be
8 punished by a minimum mandatory fine of not less than five hundred
9 dollars. The court may suspend up to one half of the fine upon a showing
10 that appropriate insurance as required pursuant to section 10-4-619 or
11 10-4-624 ~~C.R.S.~~, has been obtained. Nothing in this paragraph (a)
12 SUBSECTION (4)(a) shall be construed to prevent the court from imposing
13 a fine greater than the minimum mandatory fine.

14 (c) In addition to the penalties prescribed in paragraphs".
