HOUSE COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE AMENDMENT  
Committee on Judiciary.

HB18-1287 be amended as follows:

- 1 Amend printed bill, page 2, after line 10 insert:  
2 "SECTION 3. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 16-11.3-102, amend  
3 (2)(a) introductory portion, (2)(a)(XI) introductory portion, (2)(a)(XI)(D),  
4 (2)(a)(XI)(H), and (3)(b); and add (2)(a)(XI)(J) and (2)(a)(XI)(K) as  
5 follows:  
6 **16-11.3-102. Colorado commission on criminal and juvenile**  
7 **justice - creation - membership - operation.** (2) (a) The commission  
8 consists of ~~twenty-six~~ TWENTY-EIGHT voting members, as follows:  
9 (XI) ~~Twelve~~ FOURTEEN members appointed by the governor as  
10 follows:  
11 (D) ~~Two~~ ONE elected district attorneys ATTORNEY AND ONE  
12 REPRESENTATIVE OF A STATEWIDE ORGANIZATION REPRESENTING  
13 DISTRICT ATTORNEYS;  
14 (H) One member who is a representative of a community  
15 corrections provider, a community corrections board member, or a  
16 behavioral, mental health, or substance use disorder treatment provider;  
17 and  
18 (J) A REPRESENTATIVE OF A NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION  
19 REPRESENTING MUNICIPALITIES; AND  
20 (K) A VICTIM'S ADVOCATE, AS DEFINED IN SECTION 13-90-107  
21 (1)(k)(II).  
22 (3) (b) Each appointing authority shall appoint the initial  
23 appointed members of the commission within sixty days after May 23,  
24 2007. THE GOVERNOR SHALL APPOINT THE REPRESENTATIVE OF A  
25 STATEWIDE ORGANIZATION REPRESENTING DISTRICT ATTORNEYS  
26 DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (2)(a)(XI)(D) OF THIS SECTION AND THE  
27 COMMISSION MEMBERS DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTIONS (2)(a)(XI)(J) AND  
28 (2)(a)(XI)(K) OF THIS SECTION ON OR BEFORE JULY 1, 2018. An appointed  
29 member shall not serve more than two consecutive full terms, in addition  
30 to any partial term. In the event of a vacancy in an appointed position by  
31 death, resignation, removal for misconduct, incompetence, neglect of  
32 duty, or otherwise, the appointing authority shall appoint a member to fill  
33 the position for the remainder of the unexpired term.  
34 SECTION 4. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 16-11.3-103, add (7)  
35 and (8) as follows:  
36 **16-11.3-103. Duties of the commission - mission - staffing.**  
37 (7) ON OR BEFORE MAY 1 OF EACH EVEN-NUMBERED YEAR, THE  
38 GOVERNOR SHALL DELIVER A LETTER TO THE COMMISSION SUGGESTING  
39 TOPICS FOR THE COMMISSION TO STUDY. IN PREPARING THE LETTER, THE  
40 GOVERNOR SHALL CONSULT WITH CHIEF JUSTICE OF THE COLORADO

1 SUPREME COURT AND THE MAJORITY AND MINORITY LEADERS OF THE  
2 HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND THE SENATE.

3 (8) BILLS RECOMMENDED BY THE COMMISSION TO THE GENERAL  
4 ASSEMBLY ARE EXEMPT FROM ANY APPLICABLE BILL LIMIT IMPOSED ON  
5 THE INDIVIDUAL COMMITTEE MEMBERS SPONSORING THE BILLS IF THE  
6 BILLS ARE APPROVED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL IN ACCORDANCE WITH  
7 THE JOINT RULES OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY."
