SENATE COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE AMENDMENT

Committee on State, Veterans, & Military Affairs.SB16-156 be amended as follows:

1 Amend printed bill, strike everything below the enacting clause and
2 substitute:

3 "SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 2-3-101, **amend** (1)
4 as follows:

5 **2-3-101. Legislative audit committee - membership - meetings**
6 **- powers and duties.** (1) There is hereby created a legislative audit
7 committee, hereinafter referred to IN THIS PART 1 as the "committee". The
8 membership of the committee shall consist CONSISTS of four senators, two
9 from each major political party, to be appointed by the president AND THE
10 MINORITY LEADER of the senate, RESPECTIVELY, with the approval of a
11 majority of the members elected to the senate and four representatives,
12 two from each major political party, to be appointed by the speaker AND
13 THE MINORITY LEADER of the house of representatives, RESPECTIVELY,
14 with the approval of a majority of the members elected to the house of
15 representatives. Appointments to the committee shall be made no later
16 than sixty days after the convening of the first regular session of the
17 general assembly held in each odd-numbered year. AN APPOINTING
18 AUTHORITY MAY MAKE AN APPOINTMENT TO TEMPORARILY REPLACE A
19 CURRENT MEMBER OF THE COMMITTEE APPOINTED BY THAT APPOINTING
20 AUTHORITY; EXCEPT THAT, A TEMPORARY APPOINTMENT DOES NOT
21 REQUIRE APPROVAL OF A MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS ELECTED TO THE
22 APPLICABLE BODY. Membership on the committee shall terminate
23 TERMINATES with the appointment of a member's successor or upon the
24 termination of a member's term of office in the general assembly,
25 whichever occurs first, and any member may be appointed to succeed
26 himself OR HERSELF on the committee. Vacancies in the committee's
27 membership shall be filled in the same manner as original appointments;
28 except that the approval of the members elected to the general assembly
29 is not necessary if any such appointment is made when the general
30 assembly is not in session.

31 **SECTION 2.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 2-3-301, **amend** (1)
32 and (2) as follows:

33 **2-3-301. Legislative council created - executive committee**
34 **created.** (1) There is hereby created a legislative council, referred to in
35 this part 3 as the "council", which shall consist CONSISTS of an executive
36 committee, six senators to be WITH MAJORITY PARTY MEMBERS appointed
37 by the president of the senate AND MINORITY PARTY MEMBERS APPOINTED

1 BY THE MINORITY LEADER OF THE SENATE, with the approval of a majority
2 vote of the members elected to the senate, and six representatives ~~to be~~
3 WITH MAJORITY PARTY MEMBERS appointed by the speaker of the house
4 of representatives AND MINORITY PARTY MEMBERS APPOINTED BY THE
5 MINORITY LEADER OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, with the approval
6 of a majority vote of the members elected to the house of representatives.
7 Except as otherwise provided in subsection (1.5) of this section, the
8 executive committee ~~shall be comprised~~ CONSISTS of the president of the
9 senate, the majority leader of the senate, the minority leader of the senate,
10 the speaker of the house of representatives, the majority leader of the
11 house of representatives, and the minority leader of the house of
12 representatives, all of whom ~~shall be~~ ARE ex officio members of the
13 council. The speaker of the house of representatives and the president of
14 the senate shall alternately serve as the ~~chairman~~ CHAIR and
15 ~~vice-chairman~~ VICE-CHAIR of the executive committee and shall serve for
16 one-year terms. All ex officio members of the council shall have and MAY
17 exercise all the powers, privileges, and duties of other members.

18 (2) Appointments or reappointments of all members of the council
19 shall be made no later than ten days after the convening of the first
20 regular session of each general assembly. AN APPOINTING AUTHORITY
21 MAY MAKE AN APPOINTMENT TO TEMPORARILY REPLACE A CURRENT
22 MEMBER OF THE COMMITTEE APPOINTED BY THAT APPOINTING AUTHORITY;
23 EXCEPT THAT, A TEMPORARY APPOINTMENT DOES NOT REQUIRE APPROVAL
24 OF A MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS ELECTED TO THE APPLICABLE BODY.
25 Membership on the council ~~shall terminate~~ TERMINATES with the
26 appointment of a member's successor or upon the termination of a
27 member's term of office in the general assembly, whichever first occurs.
28 A member may be appointed to succeed himself or herself.

29 **SECTION 3.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 2-3-302, **amend** (1)
30 as follows:

31 **2-3-302. Organization - meetings.** (1) The ~~council shall select~~
32 ~~a chairman and vice-chairman from among its membership, who shall~~
33 ~~serve for one-year terms~~ CHAIR AND VICE-CHAIR OF THE EXECUTIVE
34 COMMITTEE SHALL SERVE AS THE CHAIR AND VICE-CHAIR OF THE COUNCIL;
35 and it THE COUNCIL shall prescribe its own rules of procedure, and may
36 appoint subcommittees from the membership of the general assembly and
37 other persons to assist in carrying out its functions.

38 **SECTION 4.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 2-3-502, **amend** (3)
39 and (4) as follows:

40 **2-3-502. Committee on legal services - membership - duties.**
41 (3) The membership of the committee ~~shall consist~~ CONSISTS of ten

1 members of the general assembly. The ten legislative members of the
2 committee ~~shall be~~ ARE as follows: The respective ~~chairmen~~ CHAIRS of
3 the house and senate committees on judiciary or their respective
4 designees; four members from the house of representatives, two from
5 each major political party, one of whom shall be an attorney-at-law, if
6 there is an attorney-at-law in each party, appointed by the speaker AND
7 THE MINORITY LEADER of the house of representatives, RESPECTIVELY,
8 with the approval of a majority of the members elected to the house of
9 representatives; and four members from the senate, two from each major
10 political party, one of whom shall be an attorney-at-law, if there is an
11 attorney-at-law in each party, appointed by the president AND THE
12 MINORITY LEADER of the senate, RESPECTIVELY, with the approval of a
13 majority of the members elected to the senate.

14 (4) The eight appointive members of the committee shall be
15 appointed no later than ten days after the convening of the first regular
16 session of each general assembly. ~~except that initial appointments after~~
17 ~~June 13, 1985, shall be made within ten days after such date.~~ AN
18 APPOINTING AUTHORITY MAY MAKE AN APPOINTMENT TO TEMPORARILY
19 REPLACE A CURRENT MEMBER OF THE COMMITTEE APPOINTED BY THAT
20 APPOINTING AUTHORITY. IN ADDITION, THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE
21 MAY MAKE AN APPOINTMENT TO TEMPORARILY REPLACE THE CHAIR OF
22 THE SENATE COMMITTEE ON JUDICIARY OR THE CHAIR'S RESPECTIVE
23 DESIGNEE CURRENTLY SERVING ON THE COMMITTEE AND THE SPEAKER OF
24 THE HOUSE OF THE REPRESENTATIVES MAY MAKE AN APPOINTMENT TO
25 TEMPORARILY REPLACE THE CHAIR OF THE HOUSE COMMITTEE ON
26 JUDICIARY OR THE CHAIR'S DESIGNEE CURRENTLY SERVING ON THE
27 COMMITTEE; EXCEPT THAT, A TEMPORARY APPOINTMENT MADE PURSUANT
28 TO THIS SUBSECTION (4) DOES NOT REQUIRE APPROVAL OF A MAJORITY OF
29 THE MEMBERS ELECTED TO THE APPLICABLE BODY. Membership on the
30 committee of each such appointive member ~~shall terminate~~ TERMINATES
31 upon the appointment of his OR HER successor or upon termination of A
32 MEMBER'S TERM OF office in the general assembly, whichever first occurs.
33 The membership of a judiciary committee ~~chairman shall terminate~~ CHAIR
34 TERMINATES upon the termination of his OR HER TERM OF office in the
35 designated position. Any member may be appointed to succeed himself
36 OR HERSELF on the committee. Vacancies in the committee's membership
37 shall be filled in the same manner as original appointments; except that
38 the approval of the members elected to the general assembly is not
39 necessary if any such appointment is made when the general assembly is
40 not in session.

41 **SECTION 5. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,

1 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
2 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety."

3 Page 1, line 103, strike "COMMITTEES" and substitute "COMMITTEES,
4 ALLOWING TEMPORARY APPOINTMENTS TO THE COMMITTEES,".
