SENATE COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE AMENDMENT

Committee on Agriculture & Natural Resources.

SB24-045 be amended as follows:

- 1 Amend printed bill, page 2, strike lines 5 through 10 and substitute "-
2 **rules - exceptions - violations.** (2) (a) FOR AN ANIMAL BORN IN
3 COLORADO, if a licensed veterinarian declares in writing that a
4 sterilization procedure could jeopardize the life or health of the dog or
5 cat, the procedure may be delayed until such time that a veterinarian
6 determines that the dog or cat is fit to undergo the sterilization procedure.
7 (b) FOR AN ANIMAL IMPORTED FROM A SOURCE OUTSIDE OF
8 COLORADO, IF A LICENSED VETERINARIAN DECLARES IN WRITING THAT A
9 STERILIZATION PROCEDURE COULD JEOPARDIZE THE LIFE OF THE DOG OR
10 CAT, THE PROCEDURE MAY BE DELAYED UNTIL SUCH TIME THAT A
11 VETERINARIAN DETERMINES THAT THE DOG OR CAT IS FIT TO UNDERGO THE
12 STERILIZATION PROCEDURE.
13 (c) At such time THAT A LICENSED VETERINARIAN DECLARES IN
14 WRITING THAT A STERILIZATION PROCEDURE COULD BE PERFORMED ON A
15 DOG OR CAT SAFELY, the ANIMAL SHELTER, PET ANIMAL RESCUE, OR
16 prospective owner shall have the animal sterilized.
17 (d) If ~~the~~ A determination of unfitness for sterilization has".
