AN ACT

CONCERNING THE REPEAL OF THE CAP ON THE AMOUNT OF MONEY THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION MAY EXPEND ON COSTS INCURRED IN IMPLEMENTING THE SCHOOL TRANSFORMATION GRANT PROGRAM, AND, IN CONNECTION THEREWITH, MAKING AN APPROPRIATION.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 22-13-105, **repeal** (5) as follows:

- 22-13-105. School transformation grants application awards report. (5) The department may expend up to five percent of the money annually appropriated for the program to offset the costs incurred in implementing the program.
- **SECTION 2.** Appropriation. For the 2023-24 state fiscal year, \$115,785 is appropriated to the department of education. This appropriation is from the general fund and is based on an assumption that the department will require an additional 0.9 FTE. To implement this act, the department may use this appropriation for the school transformation grant program.
- **SECTION 3. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety.
