## HOUSE FLOOR AMENDMENT

Second Reading

1 Amend the Appropriations Committee Report, dated March 18, 2025,  
2 page 1, strike lines 1 and 2 and substitute:

3 "Amend reengrossed bill, page 3, strike lines 8 through 16 and substitute:  
4 **"SECTION 2.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 2-2-1303, **amend**  
5 (2)(a)(III)(A) as follows:

6 **2-2-1303. Membership - selection - terms.**  
7 (2) (a) Nonlegislative council members shall be appointed as follows:  
8 (III) (A) On or before August 31 of each year, EXCEPT FOR  
9 AUGUST 31, 2025, the council members shall approve subsequent  
10 appointments to the council. A youth who meets the criteria set forth in  
11 subsection (1) of this section may apply to the council to be considered  
12 for participation in the council.

13 **SECTION 3.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 2-2-1304, **amend**  
14 (2)(b) and (4)(a) as follows:

15 **2-2-1304. Duties - meetings - community outreach -**  
16 **designation of organization to accept donations - authority to**  
17 **contract - repeal.** (2) (b) (I) The council shall meet at least four times  
18 each year, with two meetings occurring during the regular legislative  
19 session and two meetings occurring after the regular legislative session  
20 has concluded. Council members may attend and participate in council  
21 meetings remotely, but at least two of the council's meetings each year  
22 must be held in person, with all attending members at the same physical  
23 location. Additional meetings may be held at the discretion of council  
24 leadership, subject to available money.

25 (II) (A) NOTWITHSTANDING SUBSECTION (2)(b)(I) OF THIS  
26 SECTION, THE COUNCIL SHALL MEET ONLY ONCE AFTER THE 2025 REGULAR  
27 LEGISLATIVE SESSION, IN JULY 2025, AND THE COUNCIL SHALL NOT MEET  
28 AT ANY TIME IN THE 2026 CALENDAR YEAR.

29 (B) THIS SUBSECTION (2)(b)(II) IS REPEALED, EFFECTIVE JULY 1,  
30 2027.

31 (4) (a) (I) On or before September 1, 2013, and every third  
32 September 1 thereafter through September 1, 2019, the council shall, in  
33 conjunction with the director of the legislative council, use a request for  
34 proposal process to contract with and designate one or more nonprofit  
35 organizations to provide staffing and operational assistance and to serve  
36 as the custodian of money donated to the council through the designated  
37 organization. The contractor selected following the 2019 request for  
38 proposal process shall, pursuant to one or more contracts, provide such  
39 staffing, operational, and custodian services through June 30, 2023.  
40 Thereafter, the council shall, in conjunction with the director of the

1 legislative council, on or before April 30, 2023, and, except as otherwise  
2 provided in this subsection (4)(a), on or before every second April 15  
3 thereafter, use a request for proposal process to contract with and  
4 designate one or more nonprofit organizations to provide such staffing,  
5 operational, and custodian services. The term of each contract entered  
6 into for a term commencing on or after July 1, 2023, is two state fiscal  
7 years; except that any such contract may be extended for one additional  
8 two-year term. If a contract is extended, the request for proposal for the  
9 next contract must be issued on or before the April 15 immediately  
10 preceding the expiration of the extension term. The designated  
11 organization shall not be the custodian of any money appropriated by the  
12 state and credited to the fund created in section 2-2-1306. The designated  
13 organization is authorized to expend any money it receives as is necessary  
14 for the operation of the council and may solicit and accept monetary and  
15 in-kind gifts, grants, and donations used to further the council's duties and  
16 responsibilities. Any money donated or awarded to the designated  
17 organization for the benefit of the council is not subject to appropriation  
18 by the general assembly. Any money obtained by the council or the  
19 designated organization ~~and~~ THAT IS not in the fund AND that is  
20 unexpended and unencumbered at the time the council is dissolved shall  
21 be distributed according to appropriate federal and state laws governing  
22 nonprofit organizations. If a different nonprofit or private organization is  
23 subsequently designated as the custodian of donated money in accordance  
24 with this ~~paragraph (a)~~ SUBSECTION (4)(a)(I), any money that is  
25 unexpended and unencumbered at the time of the change in designation  
26 shall be promptly transferred by the previously designated organization  
27 to the newly designated organization.

28 (II) NOTWITHSTANDING SUBSECTION (4)(a)(I) OF THIS SECTION:

29 (A) THE COUNCIL AND DIRECTOR OF THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
30 SHALL NEITHER CONTRACT WITH NOR DESIGNATE ONE OR MORE  
31 NONPROFIT ORGANIZATIONS TO PROVIDE STAFFING, OPERATIONAL, AND  
32 CUSTODIAN SERVICES FOR THE PERIOD BEGINNING ON JULY 1, 2025, AND  
33 ENDING ON JUNE 30, 2027; AND

34 (B) THE CONTRACT THAT TERMINATES ON JULY 1, 2025, IS  
35 EXTENDED FOR ONE MONTH TO ALLOW THE COUNCIL THE OPPORTUNITY TO  
36 PRESENT ITS REPORT TO THE REVIEW COMMITTEE IN JULY 2025. THE  
37 CONTRACT TERMINATES ON AUGUST 1, 2025.

38 (III) SUBSECTION (4)(a)(II) OF THIS SECTION AND THIS SUBSECTION  
39 (4)(a)(III) ARE REPEALED, EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2027.

40 **SECTION 4.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 2-2-1305.5, **add**  
41 (5)(c) and (6)(c) as follows:

42 **2-2-1305.5. Representative Hugh McKean Colorado youth**  
43 **advisory council review committee - created - repeal.**

1 (5) (c) (I) NOTWITHSTANDING SUBSECTION (5)(a) OF THIS SECTION, THE  
2 REVIEW COMMITTEE MAY MEET ONLY ONCE AFTER THE 2025 REGULAR  
3 LEGISLATIVE SESSION, IN JULY 2025, TO HEAR THE REPORT OF THE  
4 COUNCIL.

5 (II) NOTWITHSTANDING SUBSECTION (5)(a) OF THIS SECTION, THE  
6 REVIEW COMMITTEE SHALL NOT MEET DURING THE 2026 INTERIM.

7 (III) THIS SUBSECTION (5)(c) IS REPEALED, EFFECTIVE JULY 1,  
8 2027.

9 (6) (c) (I) NOTWITHSTANDING SUBSECTION (6)(a) OF THIS SECTION,  
10 THE REVIEW COMMITTEE SHALL NOT RECOMMEND LEGISLATION DURING  
11 THE 2025 OR 2026 INTERIM.

12 (II) THIS SUBSECTION (6)(c) IS REPEALED, EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2027.

13 **SECTION 5.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 25-1.5-111, **amend**  
14 (2)(a)(XI) as follows:

15 **25-1.5-111. Suicide prevention commission - created -**  
16 **responsibilities - gifts, grants, or donations - reimbursement for**  
17 **expenses - definition - repeal.** (2) (a) The executive director of the  
18 department shall appoint to the commission no more than twenty-two  
19 members, including:

20 (XI) A representative from the Colorado youth advisory council,  
21 IF THE COLORADO YOUTH ADVISORY COUNCIL HAS APPOINTED MEMBERS;".

22 Renumber succeeding sections accordingly.

23 Page 9 of the bill, line 15, strike "\$267,807" and substitute "292,488".

24 Page 1 of the committee report, line 4, strike "\$104,161," and  
25 substitute "124,284".

26 Page 1 of the committee report, line 5, strike "1.3 FTE;" and substitute  
27 "1.6 FTE;".

28 Page 1 of the committee report, strike lines 8 through 16.

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
