- 6 Page 6, line 10, strike "STANDARDS" and substitute "STANDARDS,
- 7 INCLUDING STANDARDS SPECIFIC TO CHILDREN AND YOUTH, WHEN

- 21 BEHAVIORAL HEALTH ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES ORGANIZATIONS AND
- 22 REPORT THE ACTUAL PERFORMANCE OF EACH BEHAVIORAL HEALTH
- 23 ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES ORGANIZATION ANNUALLY,".
